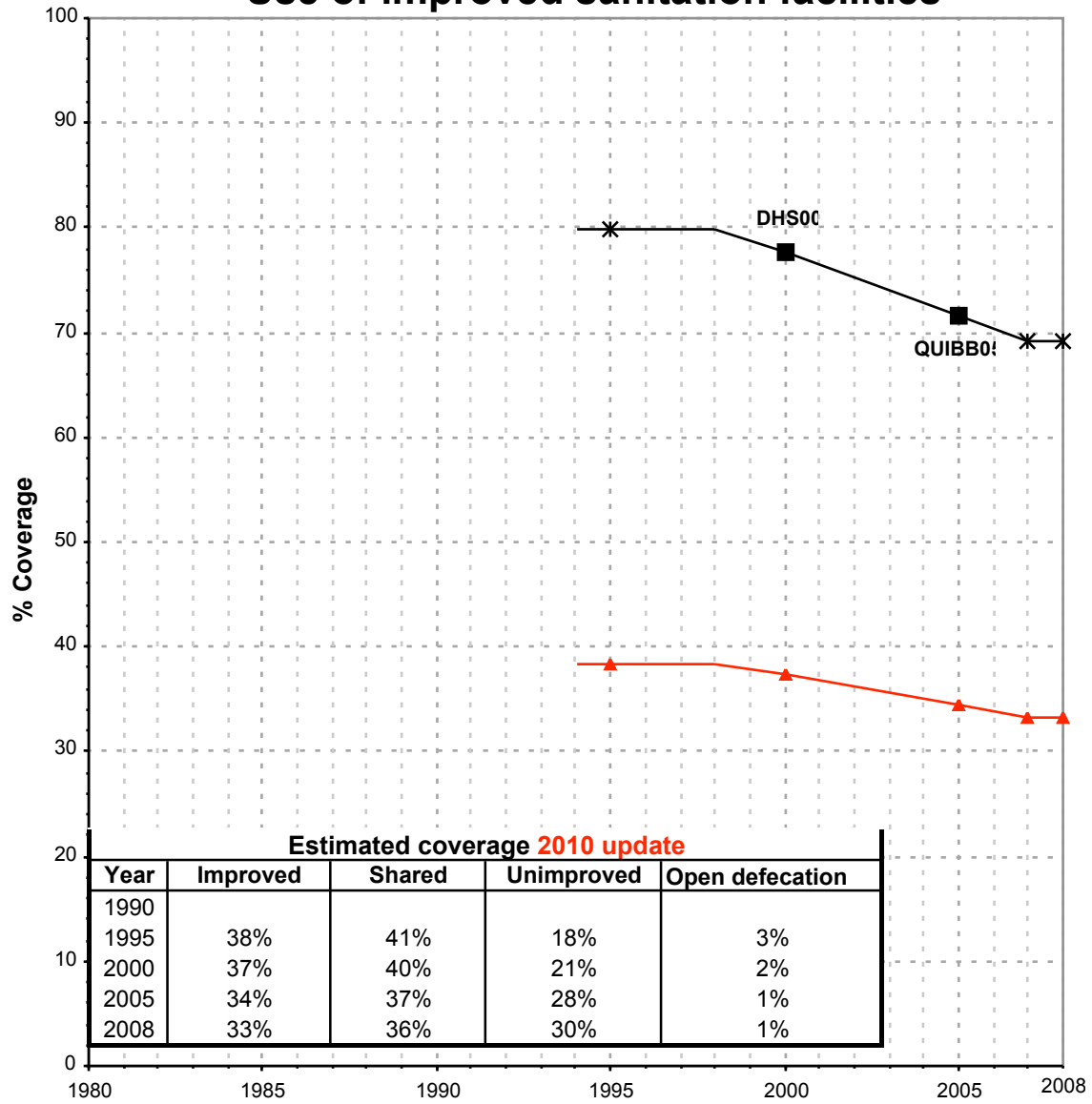

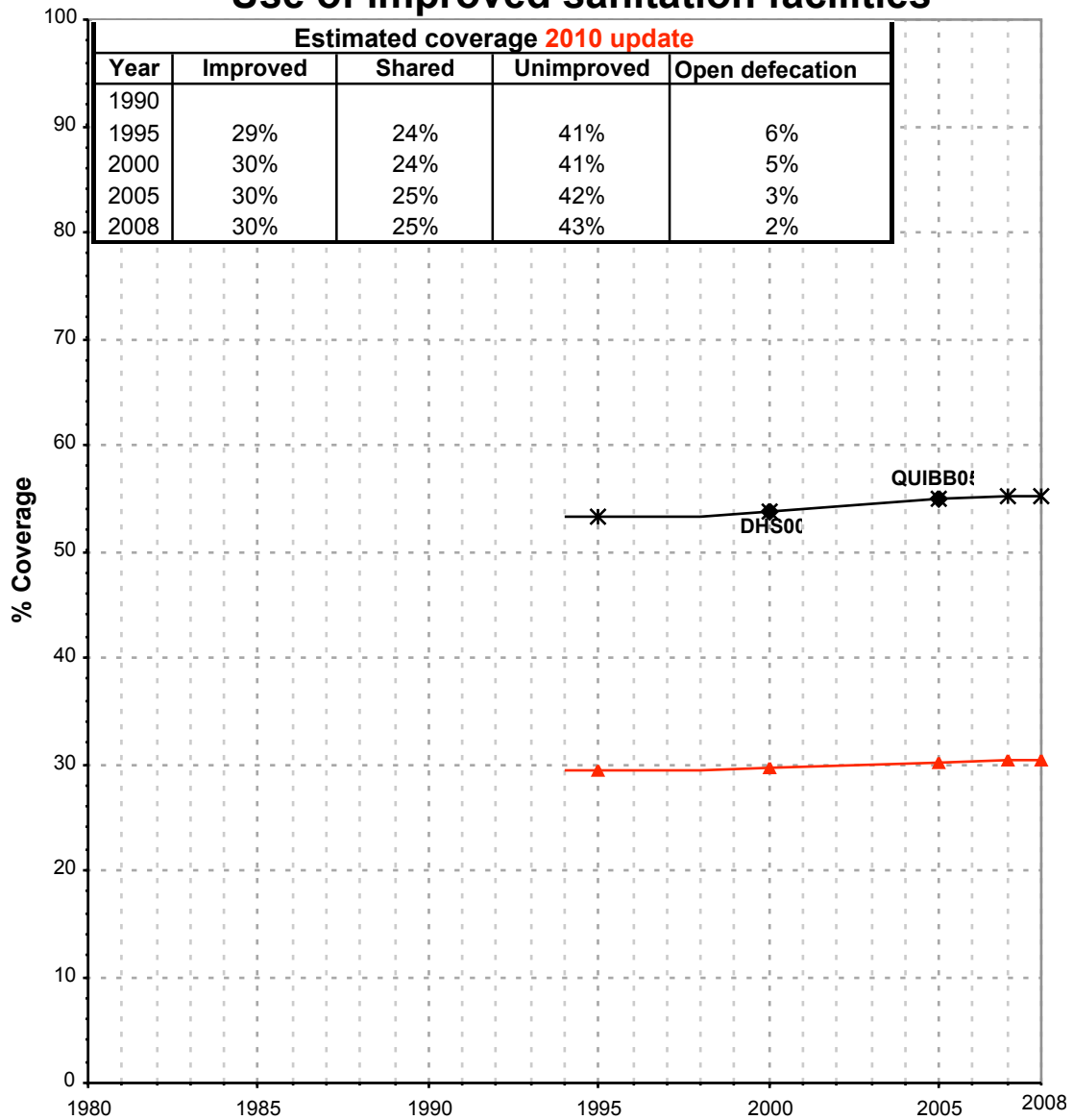

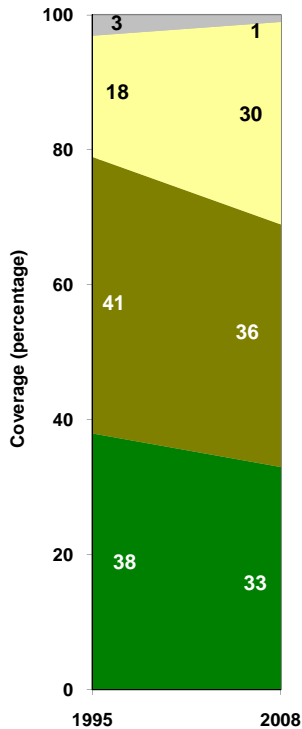

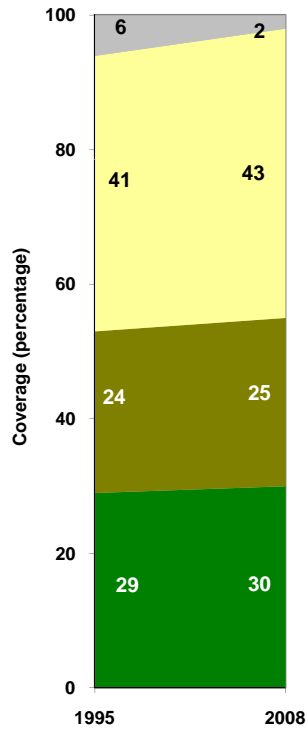

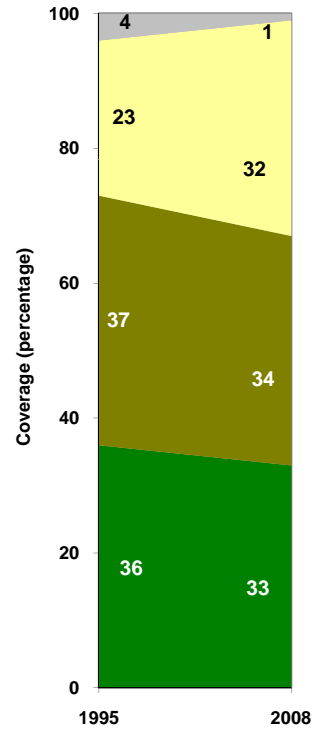
Urban sanitation trends
