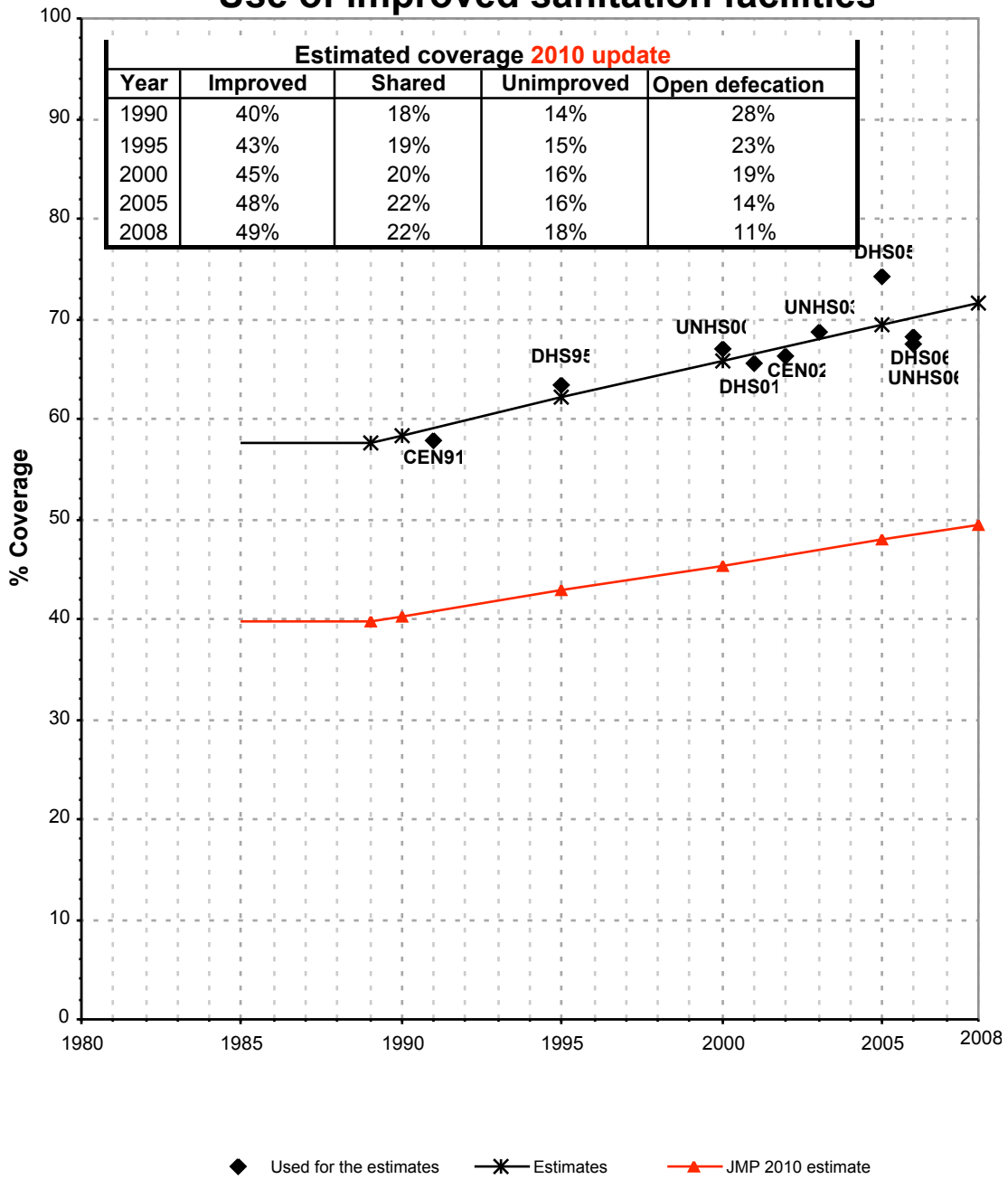

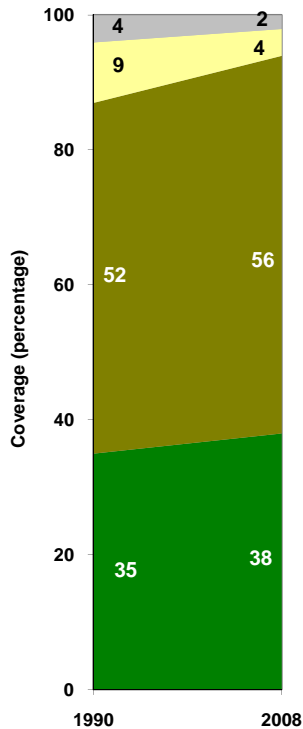

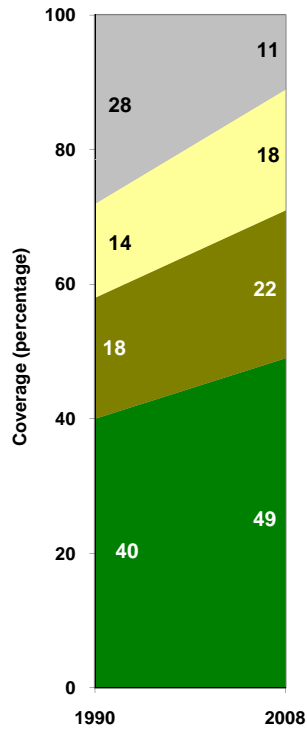

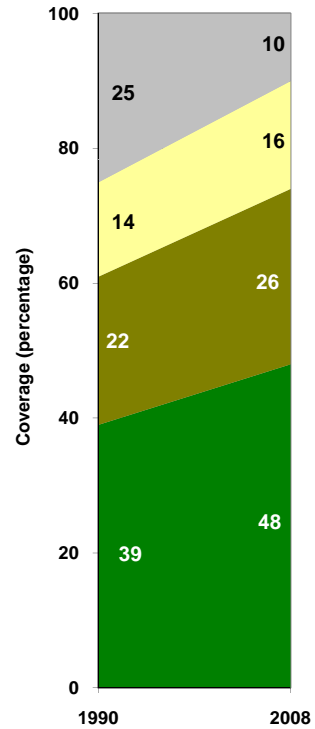
Urban sanitation trends
