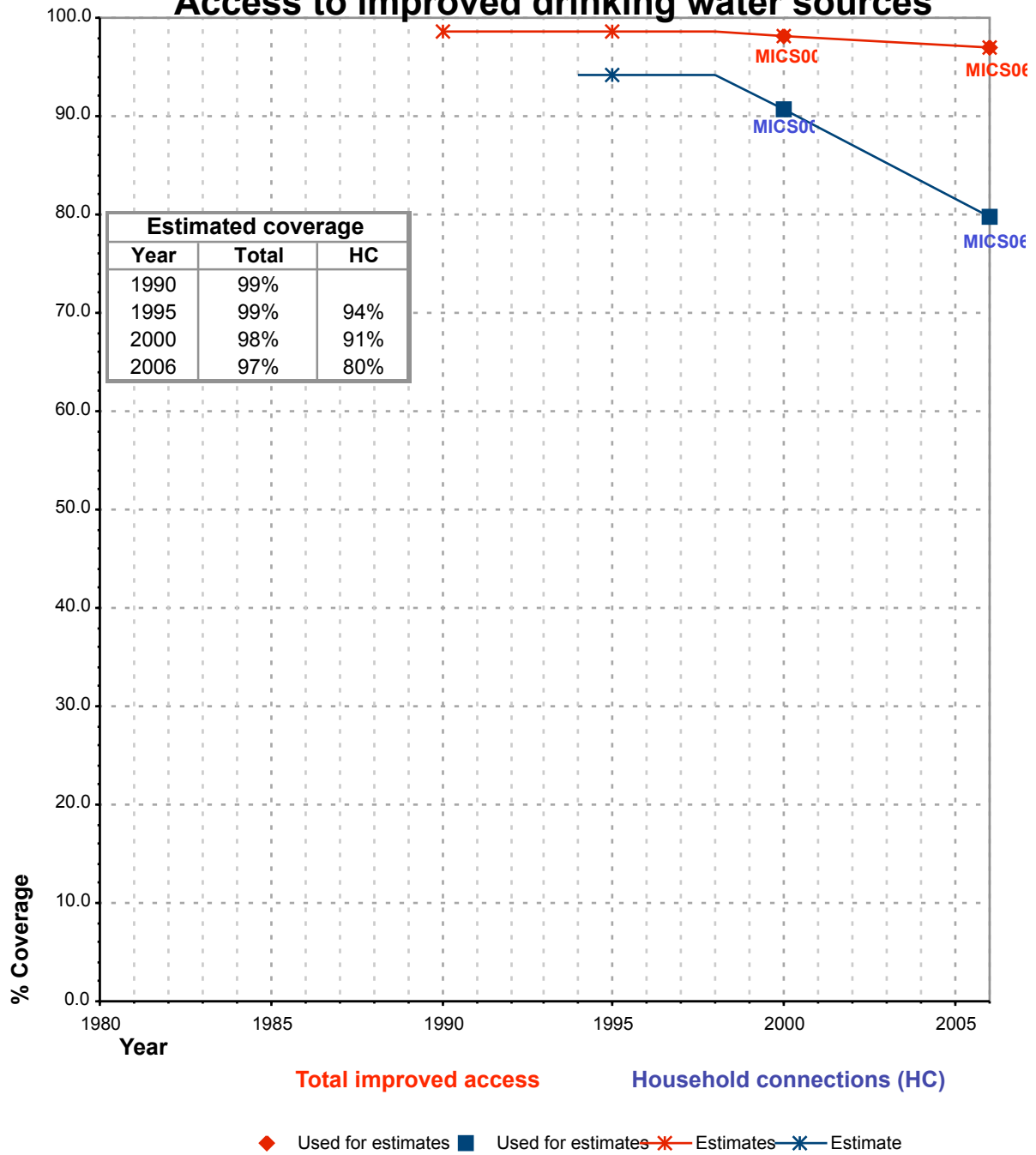

Suriname - urban - Access to improved drinking water sources

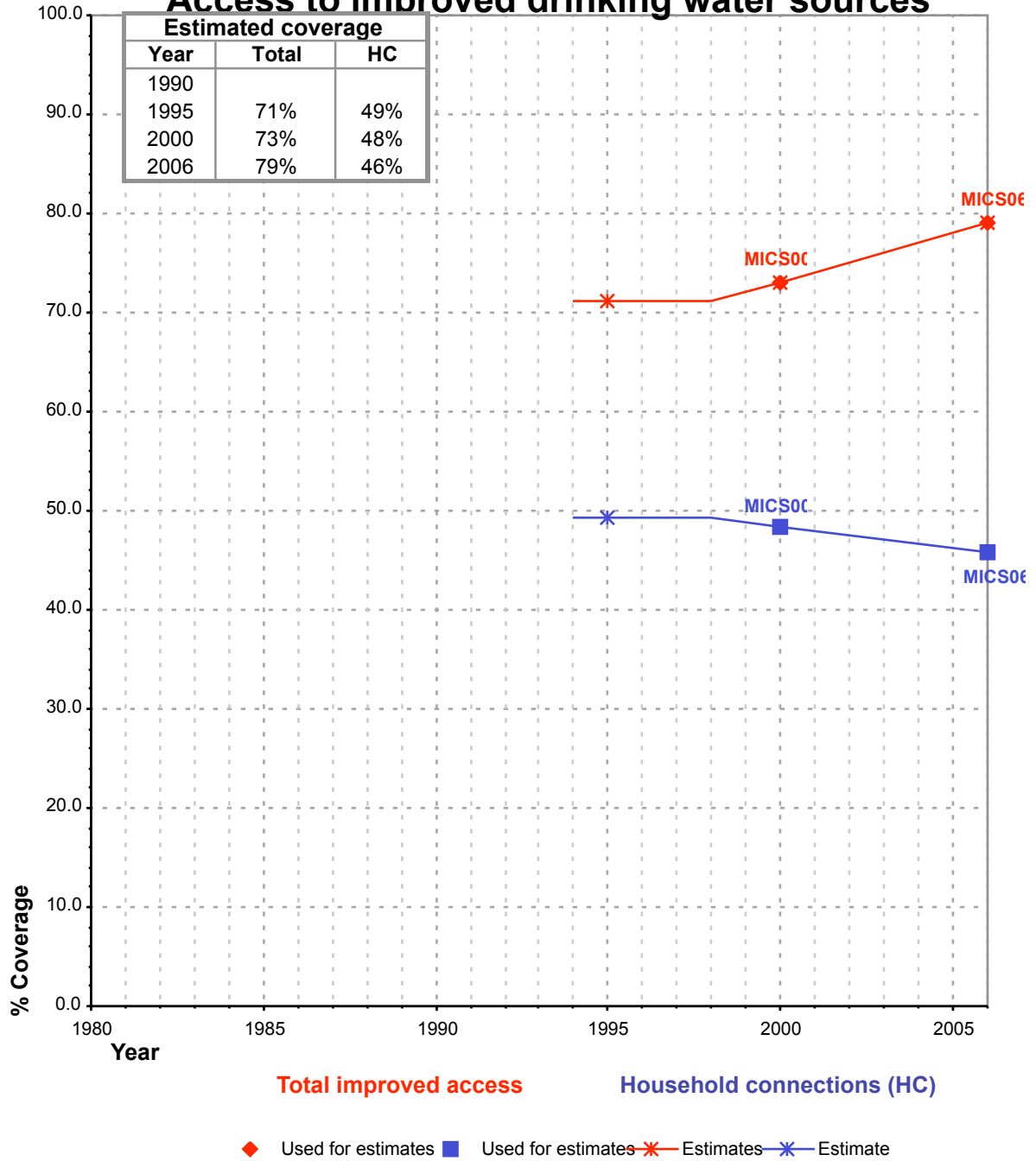
