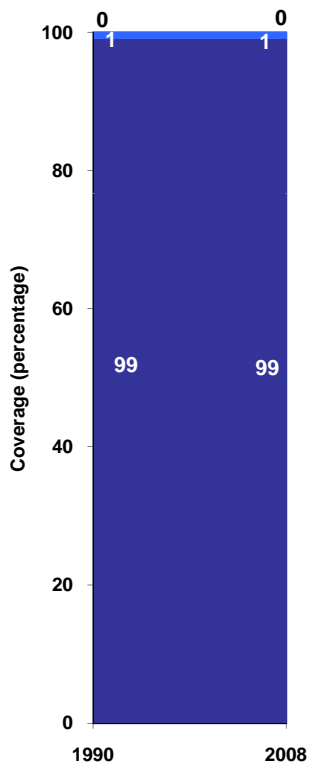

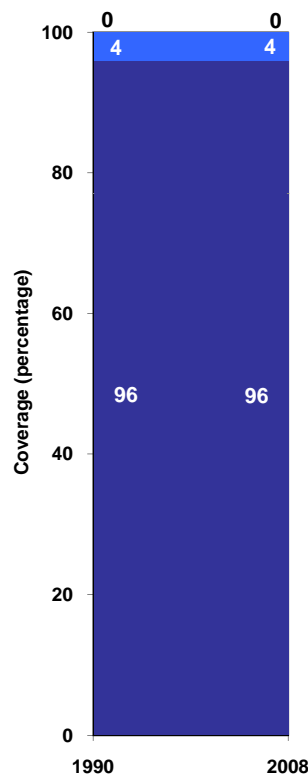

Urban drinking water trends



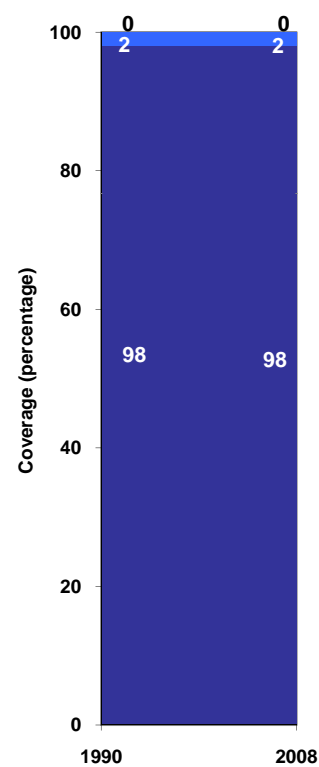
